If Christ's sacrifice on the cross would exhibit an explosive impact throughout the world it would be His perfect demonstration of His ability to perfectly trust His Heavenly Father before the world began, to raise Christ from the dead. In God's Love Christ would demonstrate his ability to be the substitute for his elect remnant; for no sinner in themselves are capable of obeying God's law perfectly including the work of believing on God for their salvation: only God in Christ is able to do the perfect work of believing through His perfect faithfulness which alone can make the sinner right again with God. The Flesh is useless (a flooded earth - a desolate) if it is not wholly being moved to exhibit the glory of God; by the Spirit of Christ who is life eternal; for those He indwells Christ is come in the flesh (1Jo 4:2-3).
