His Name is called the Word of God and there is none other name given among men whereby we must be saved:

If the holy bible is the word of our Creator, who created the heavens and the earth, and the sea and everything that moveth there-in, and if Jesus is the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, upholding all things by the word of his power — who by himself purged the sins of the world, and sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high; (Joshua 1:5; Isaiah 45:17; Colosians 1:16-19; Hebrews 1:3); then why doesn't the majority of, "the human race", celebrate Him as such? From the Bible, and in John 3:20, His word declares:

John 3:20 For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved.

Could John 3:20 be speaking about a whole lot more people than might first be thought? For example, in Psalm 14:2-3 God declares:

Psalm 14:2-3 The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, and seek God. 3 They are all gone aside, they are all together become filthy: there is none that doeth good, no, not one.

Wonderfully, God is not done speaking on this matter; and in John 3:21 His Word declares:

John 3:21 But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.

In John 17:17, God's word the Bible declares where truth comes from, and how it is proclaimed throughout the world:

John 17:17 ¶ Sanctify them through thy truth: **thy word is truth**. 18 As thou hast sent me into the world, even so **have I also sent them into the world**.

The bible reveals that those who fear God cannot help but witness God's word that His truth might be heard according to His light while in a spiritually dark world. For example: in Isaiah 50:10, His Word declares:

Isaiah 50:10 ¶ Who is among you that feareth the LORD, that obeyeth the voice of his servant, that walketh in darkness, and hath no light? let him trust in the name of the LORD, and stay upon his God.

And in Psalm 119:105 His word declares:

Psalm 119:105 Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.

Therefore, it is by His truth and light that many shall come to understand how Jesus can declare in John 14:6:

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

For those who truly love God; **Jesus is the word of God**, which, on this earth, is circumscribed, [limited], by the Holy Bible. In John 1:1, and in verse 14, His Word declares:

John 1:1 ¶ In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God ... 14 And **the Word was made flesh**, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

And in Revelations 19:13 His word declares:

Revelations 19:13 And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God.

In Acts 4:10-12, Peter, an elect of God, (1Peter 1:2), and filled with the Holy Ghost, prophesied of the one true hope for those in the world that would love God 'for His Names sake':

Acts 4:10-12 Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole. 11 This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner. 12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

And in Psalm 69:33-36; God, through the spirit of Christ, imparts yet another wonderful portion of His Word that can assure His people:

Psalm 69:33-36 For the LORD heareth the poor, and despiseth not his prisoners. 34 Let the heaven and earth praise him, the seas, and every thing that moveth therein. 35 For God will save Zion, and will build the cities of Judah: that they may dwell there, and have it in possession. 36 The seed also of his servants shall inherit it: and they that love his name shall dwell therein.
